The idea was proposed to move the shower to the south, same side as the door to eliminate the opening of the bathroom door onto the Ramada. Will reassess project in November. In the event the project get's rolled over to 2011, the \$15,000 which was approved by CPA members should be rolled over into the 2011 budget.
